

8th Grade Annual Class Trip to Disney World June 5th-9th, 2017

Dear Parent:

We are preparing for our 15th annual trip to Walt Disney World to participate in the Disney YES educational program. Students will travel to Orlando on Monday June 5th via motor coach from AMS to the airport and from Orlando Airport by coach bus to the Walt Disney World Resort. Students will spend the next four nights in quad occupancy rooms at a Disney All-Star Resort. During the morning, students will participate in the Youth Education Series offered by Walt Disney World, and travel in chaperoned groups throughout the parks in the afternoons and evenings. (Average chaperone to student ratio is 1 to 4). We will again be traveling with a licensed nurse who will dispense prescribed medications and address any health issues that may arise. We will also be hiring Disney Security to ensure the safety of our students during the overnight hours. Students will return to AMS on Friday, June 9th.

What's included:

- ✓ Motor Coach from AMS to and from airport
- ✓ Round trip airfare
- ✓ All transfers to and from Orlando Airport and Disney Parks
- ✓ 4 nights quad occupancy at Disney All Star Resort
- ✓ All meals with the exception of eating at the airport (we suggest children bring \$10 for each way for snacks or meal in the event of flight delay)
- ✓ Participation in the Y.E.S. program
- ✓ Admission to theme parks

Chaperones: We encourage all parents to consider chaperoning this trip. Chaperone cost is *TBD* and includes dual occupancy rooms and all travel, meal and park admissions. Information is included in this packet for chaperone sign up.

- 11/23/16** Trip balance statement provided to students
- Late Nov.** Wreath pick up at Mr. Costello's house for student delivery
- 1/20/17** **Final Payment Due for Students and Chaperones**
