



Home Medical Waste



Hazards

- May infect other people who come in contact with trash.
- Unwanted or expired medicines or pharmaceuticals could be harmful to children or adults.
- Antibiotics poured down the drain can kill beneficial microbes and bacteria in septic systems and may adversely affect fish and other marine organisms.



Handling

- Keep sharp objects such as needles, syringes, and lancets in secure containers out of the reach of children. Do not use glass.



Management Options

- By law, once a prescription has been issued, the pharmacy cannot take it back.
- See MassDEP's instructions for safe disposal of unwanted medications [/dep/toxics/stypes/medshome.htm](http://dep.toxics/stypes/medshome.htm).
- Individuals who have received cancer treatment drugs or radioactive medicines should follow specific instructions issued by the hospital on disposal of radioactive waste materials.
- Place disposable sheets, medical gloves, and soiled bandages in plastic bags and securely close before you put them in the trash.
- For disposal of medical sharps such as needles, syringes, and lancets, see the Proper Use and disposal of Syringes <http://www.mass.gov/eohhs/provider/guidelines-resources/clinical-treatment/diseases-conditions/hiv-aids/needle-and-syringe-purchase-sale-use-and.html> compiled by the Department of Public Health, which includes a listing of local collection sites in Massachusetts. These sites include municipal government offices, hospitals, medical offices and pharmacies. Several of the companies listed below pick up disposed sharps from these local facilities and also can direct you to one in your community or area.
- If no sharps collection program is available, purchase a postage paid mail back container to have your sharps disposed through a medical waste incinerator. Several of the companies below have mail-back programs for sharps. Each provides a variety of container sizes with prepaid mailing cartons. When the container is full, it can be placed in its carton and mailed directly to their designated facility for incineration.

Proper Use and Disposal of Needles and Syringes

Be Smart. Be Careful. Be Aware. Be Safe.

If you're one of the many people in Massachusetts who uses syringes to manage your health care at home, Here's what you need to know about the safe use and disposal of needles, syringes and lancets (sharps).

Be Smart. Use a Sharps Container.

A sharps container is a single-use container that is filled with used medical needles and then disposed of safely. These can be purchased at pharmacies, medical supply stores or ordered through the mail. If you do not have access to a sharps container, place sharps in a puncture resistant container such as a rigid plastic bottle or coffee can with a secure cap. These items must be disposed of at a drop off site or through a medical mail back service.

- DO** Visit a medical supply store to purchase sharps containers.
- DO** Call the AIDS Action Committee Pharmacy Access Hotline to find out more about personal sharps containers. 1-800-988-5209
- DO** Check out these sharps mail back services. They provide a variety of container sizes and prepaid mailing cartons:

- DO NOT** Put sharps in the household trash. As of July 1, 2012, medical waste regulations do not allow the disposal of sharps in household garbage. Take your filled sharps container to the sharps disposal (drop-off) site in your community. Sharps disposal programs may be ongoing or provided on specific dates, as determined by your city of town.

Be Careful.

Protect yourself, your community, your environment, and family and friends. The proper disposal of needles and syringes is important!

- DO** Put used syringes in sharps container immediately.
- DO** Keep needles away from children and pets.
- DO** Bring a sharps container when traveling.
- DO NOT** Throw sharps in the garbage or recycling bins.
- DO NOT** Flush sharps down the toilet or drop into storm drains.
- DO NOT** Clip, bend or recap needles.

Be Aware.

Needles, syringes and sharps containers may not be thrown in the garbage or in recycling bins. See the attached list to find a disposal site for your community. If your community is not listed, please contact your local board of health for information.

Be Safe.

Reduce your risk of blood-borne diseases like hepatitis and HIV/AIDS.

- DO** Use a new needle every time you inject.
- DO** Clean the injection site with soapy water, alcohol swabs or rubbing alcohol.
- DO** Find out your HIV/viral hepatitis status. Get tested. If you are not infected you can stay that way. If you are, find out how to take care of yourself and avoid passing HIV/viral hepatitis to others.
- DO** Clean your sharps with bleach IF you must reuse them.
- DO NOT** Inject in the same spot over and over again.
- DO NOT** Share needles, syringes, cookers, cotton or water.

Sale and Possession of Hypodermic Syringes and Needles in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts:
(M.G.L. chapter 94C, sections 27, 27A and 32L)

- Individuals 18 years and older may legally purchase syringes and needles from a pharmacy without a prescription
- Disposal of syringes must be done safely and responsibly.

(M.G.L. chapter 94C, sections 27, 27A and 32L)
