Curbside white goods collection appliances such as stove/range, dishwashers, water heaters, refrigerators (remove door), AC's, freezers, double ovens, stack laundry, dehumidifiers, washers, dryers and other light iron goods curbside with the purchase of a white goods collection sticker. Stickers may be obtained through the Public Works dept. Fees: \$30 for items with Freon (AC, refrigerators) and \$20 for all other white goods. Collection is once a month.
