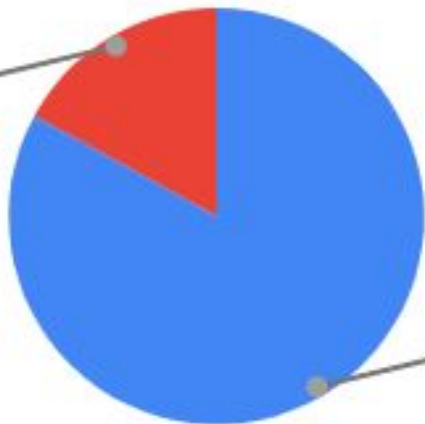

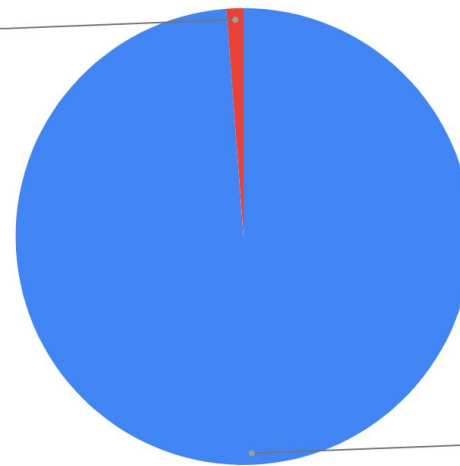

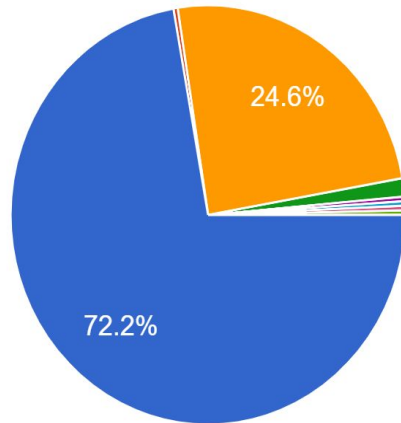
Mask Optional for AHS beginning tomorrow, February 16th.

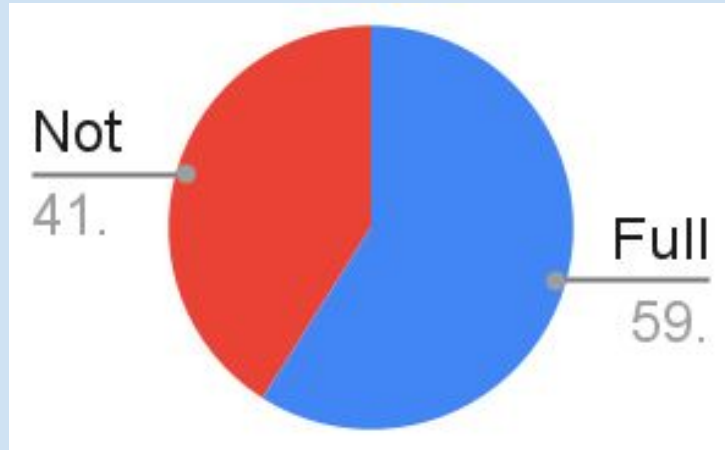

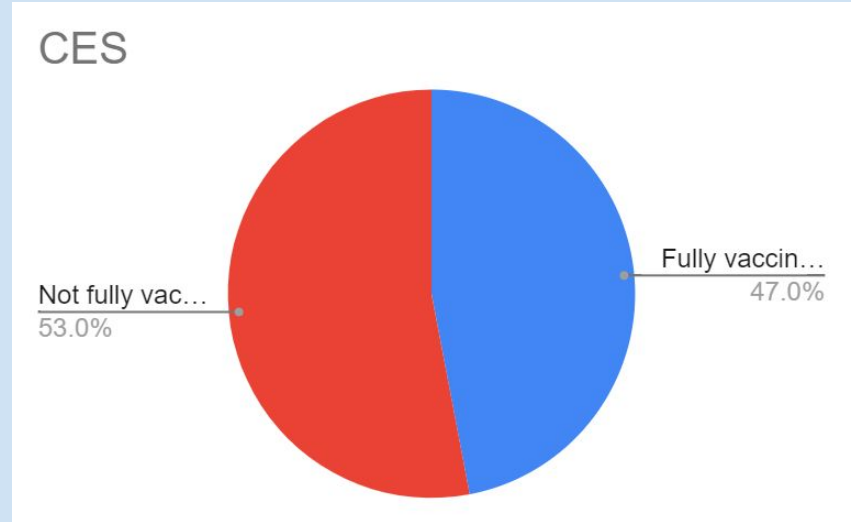

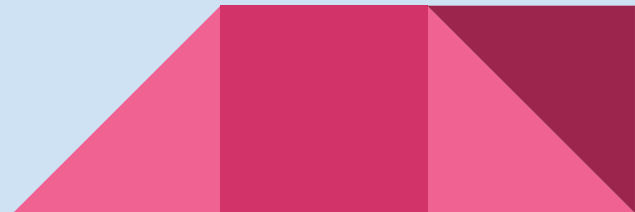
