

#### **Program Hours & Ages**

The Boys and Girls Club of the Lower Merrimack Valley Summer Adventure Program is a non-profit summer program, serving children in grades 1 - 6. The all day program provides fun activities from 9 AM to 4 PM, Monday through Friday. Additionally early and late supervision is available from 7 AM to 6 PM at no additional cost. The Club closes promptly at 6 PM. A fee of \$1 per minute will be charged if a member is picked up past 6 PM.

#### **Registration & Fees**

- There is a mandatory, one time registration fee of \$50 per family.
- The fees include a camp T-shirt, which MUST be worn on all field trips. Replacement of a T-shirt will incur a \$10 fee for each additional shirt.
- The cost of the Summer Adventure Program is \$140/week. A non-refundable \$50 deposit per session is required to reserve your child's slot. Ask about our special family pricing.
- Campers are allowed to bring spending money, no more than \$10 is suggested, for field trips and snack purchasing.
- Lunches are not provided. Members should bring their own lunch every day. Microwaveable meals are not allowed.
- All children attending the Summer Adventure Program must be a current BGC LMV member. Yearly dues are \$40.
- 6 year olds entering the first grade in the fall may attend summer camp.

NOTE: Balances are to be paid the THURSDAY BEFORE member is to attend camp unless other arrangements have been made. Members with pas due balances will not be allowed to attend field trips. A \$5/week late fee is charged for all past due balances. Financial aid is always available. No child will be turned away due to financial aid.

#### **Registration & Fees**

- All children attending the Teen Summer Adventure Program must be current BGC LMV members. Yearly dues are \$40.
- Weekly field trips to Hodgies on Tuesday and Movies on Thursday cost \$5 cash.
