American Literature College Preparatory (CP) English [1 book]

1. Faculty Favorite

Choose **one** faculty favorite from the list and be prepared for a written test and an oral discussion on **Friday, September 7, 2018**. This will count as a test grade in the student's English class regardless of which semester he/she will be enrolled.

Honors American Studies II/ Honors American Literature II [3 books]

1. *The Grapes of Wrath* by John Steinbeck

On Thursday, August 30, 2018, you will have a test on this book. Journals are not required, but you might want to take notes on plot, characters, themes, etc. to help you review. We recommend you get started on this book right away.

2. *The Things They Carried* by Tim O'brien

On **Tuesday, September 4, 2018**, you will take a test on this book. If you have English second semester, you **must** come during "A" block or after school on the 4th to take this.
