Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

The end of the school year is upon us and I'd like to review a few procedures that need to happen before the last day of school.

- Lost books If a student has lost a book/textbook/library book they should have brought home a Lost Book Form which states the replacement cost. This money is due by <u>June 1st</u>. If paying by check, please make check payable to *Amesbury Public Schools*. The form with check attached should be returned to the teacher who sent home the form. If money is not paid, students will not be allowed to participate in field days. If the book is found later, you may request a refund.
- 2. <u>Lunch room charges</u> If you owe money to the cafeteria, please pay as soon as possible. Starting June 1st, there will be no charging. If paying by check please make check payable to the Amesbury School Lunch. Payments should go to the AMS cafeteria manager. If lunch room charges have not paid in full by June 1st, students will not be allowed to participate in field days.
- 3. Field Days Dupere Field Days are scheduled for June 5th sixth grade, June 6th seventh grade, and June 7th fifth grade, and June 14th eighth grade. It's a good idea to have your child wear sunscreen and they may bring a water bottle to school if they wish. Parents are welcome to come by and watch field days. They will begin approximately at 8:15 a.m. each day. Any unpaid charges must be paid by June 1st in order for students to be allowed to participate in field day events.
- 4. <u>Clubs & after school programs</u> The last day for after school clubs is <u>June 8th</u>. The last day for Homework Club is <u>June 7th</u>.
- 5. <u>Supply lists for 2018-2019</u> Supply lists for the next school year will be coming out shortly and will be posted on the AMS website. Each grade has its own supply list.
- 6. Next year's teams By the 2nd or 3rd week of August, we will send a BlackBoard Connect telephone message to your home announcing the team and homeroom your student(s) will be in for the upcoming school year.
- 7. <u>Last day of school</u> The last day of school is June 21st. It is a half-day, with a 10:50 a.m. dismissal.
- 8. <u>AMS summer hours</u> The AMS office will be open Monday Thursday from 8:00 a.m. 1:00 p.m. We will be closed Fridays.

We wish you a safe, healthy summer and look forward to next year.

Dear Parents/Guardians of 8th Grade Students:

I would like to take this opportunity to make you and your student aware of some important information and dates regarding our end of the year plans at AMS. Please note the following dates/activities:

June 14 Field Day - sunscreen & water bottle recommended; parents are welcome to come by and watch

June 21 8th Grade Promotional Ceremony – 6:15 p.m. Farewell Dance – 7:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.

Students and parents/guardians should arrive at the school promptly at 6:00 p.m. for a 6:15 p.m. promotional ceremony being held in the performance center. Only students who have met the academic requirements for promotion are eligible to participate in the ceremony. Eighth grade students will be expected to report to the performance center no later than 6:00 p.m. to prepare. The ceremony will last approximately 30-40 minutes.

At the conclusion of the ceremony, students will leave the performance center and attend the Farewell Dance in the cafeteria from 7:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. The dance is not a semi-formal. Any eighth grade student may attend the dance as long as they are in good standing with meeting all end of the year obligations such as lunch charges, library book returns, lost book fines, detentions, etc. by June 1, 2018. Also, students that have not met these obligations will not be allowed to attend field day on June 14th.





Our Neighbors' Table is now accepting registrations for the 2018 Summer Lunch Program. This program will offer extra groceries each week to families in need living in one of the twelve communities we serve. The groceries will be designed to assist families in providing healthy breakfast, lunch, and snacks for their children during the summer months. The program is geared towards children in all grades.

How to participate: Pre-registration is mandatory and will be accepted on a rolling basis until all of the slots are filled.

How to pre-register? The registration process is easy. To register, simply phone Our Neighbors Table at 978-388-1907 and tell our receptionist that you'd like to register for our Summer Lunch Program. Our receptionist will take your name and contact info and that's it, you are registered. With the help of ONT staff, you will need to fill out a simple application upon your first visit to pick up your summer lunch items. There isn't a financial requirement to be eligible to participate in our Summer Lunch Program, however, priority will be given to families whose children are eligible to receive the free or reduced meals programs through the Public School System.
