TRANSPORTATION

The Amesbury Public Schools will be providing transportation for students in accordance with School Committee Policy EEAA. Students in Grades K-6 who reside 2 or more miles from their assigned school are transported at no charge. Students in Grades K-6 who live less than 2 miles from their assigned school and all students in Grades 7-12 are eligible for fee-based transportation (fees waived at this time) at established bus stops.

All students must register for their transportation by filling out the form located on our district website at https://schools.amesburyma.gov/. You will be required to have your student's ID number available to register. Once students have registered, bus passes will be disseminated to the student's schools. It is very important that each student be registered.

Initially, students will be allowed to ride the bus without a pass. You will find bus routes, bus stops and times also located on our district website referenced above.

Students <u>are required to wear masks at all times on the bus</u> and will be spaced according to "socially distanced" requirements. One student per seat (siblings may sit together). Buses will be sanitized between routes.
