Summer is a time to relax, have fun adventures and read for pleasure.

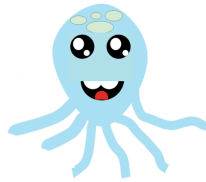
Please keep a list of the titles and authors of the books you read on the
