It's hard to believe that I have already met with parents about their children starting Kindergarten next year! We had a great turnout at our information session last night. Once again, please check with any neighbors or friends who have children turning five (5) on or before September 1 and have them contact us if they haven't done so already. You would be surprised at how many parents call us in late August and ask about signing up their child for Kindergarten!

And at the other end of our age span, tomorrow marks the official start of MCAS for AES. We ask all of our students to help us out during MCAS by being extra quiet when they are moving about the building. We hope that building this sense of community helps children understand that even if you aren't the one taking the test, you can show your support in many ways.
