Attached is a list of all local scholarships for which you may apply. Some scholarships require a special application as indicated, and others, the standard Guidance Center application. All may be obtained from the Guidance Center secretary. Students are encouraged to apply for all scholarships for which they are eligible.

The various scholarship committees, which will award scholarships, will be sent your application, the required letter, resume, teacher recommendations as well as a copy of your transcript. As the application and letter are your only contact with the organization, it is suggested that you type or print carefully, erase mistakes if necessary, spell correctly, and use bonded white 8 1/2 by 11 typing paper. A business format should be followed.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION TIPS

FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS by completing all requirements and observing all deadlines. Be early if possible. Remember, this will be your only way to present yourself to the scholarship committees.

Make sure that the application is **NEATLY DONE**.

In answering all questions, **BE YOURSELF** and don't answer the questions the way you think we want them answered. Do, however, remember that you are applying for a substantial amount of money, therefore slang, abbreviations and crude language does not belong in any part of the application.

The required **LETTER** should be typed. Read over your letter first for grammar and spelling (use spell/grammar check) and have someone else read it for you. Please do not make your letter more than 250 words.

You are **RESPONSIBLE** for copying each application, letter, resume and teacher recommendations. You must staple your application, letter, resume and teacher applications for each scholarship. The Guidance Staff and the Office Staff **CAN NOT** copy your scholarship information.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

On the generic application – fill out everything except the name of the scholarship and your signature.

Take it somewhere to get it copied. The clerical staff in the main office and guidance **MAY NOT** copy it for you. It is **YOUR** responsibility. This includes Mrs. Lavenson.

Once everything is copied fill in the name of the scholarship and sign your name. **PLEASE MAKE THEM ALL ORIGINAL SIGNATURES.**

Unless specified they are to be put together in this way:

Application, Your Letter, Resume and Teacher Recommendation stapled at the top left hand corner.

For the Lions and Rotary – Fill only one application for the Lions and one application for the Rotary Scholarship. This puts you in the running for all of them. On your letter put Dear Rotary Scholarship Committee or Dear Lions Club Scholarship Committee.

By you signing all of your scholarship applications, it gives the Guidance Center permission to attach a transcript to each application that requires it.

You must fill out the list of all the scholarships that you apply to. When turning in the applications and list, you must sit with Mrs. Bixby so that each application can be verified.

Awarded to a student planning on furthering his/her education with preference given to students considering entering the business field and demonstrating commitment to community service.

AMESBURY EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION, INC/KEVIN F. CASSIDY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (2 at \$1,000 each)

Awarded to students in memory of Kevin Cassidy, Jr., a member of the graduated class of 2002. The recipient should have participated in extracurricular activities.

AMESBURY EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION, INC./JORDAY SHAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (2 at \$1,000 each)

Awarded to a student needing financial aid with emphasis on students wanting to go into criminal justice, fire science or related field. The student should demonstrate Jordan's qualities of compassion, loyalty and independent thinking. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

AFT AMESBURY SCHOLARSHIP (2 at \$500.00 each)

Awarded to student(s) who need financial aid to continue his/her education in a four-year college program. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

AMESBURY HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1945 (1 at \$1,000.00)

Awarded to a student of the graduating class to help further his/her education.

AMESBURY HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1954 SCHOLARSHIP (2 at \$1,000.00 each)

Awarded on the basis of need, excellence in studies, character and community and school service. Preference will be given to a student who demonstrates a determination in improving the community and world around them.

AMESBURY HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1961 (1 at \$500.00) GIVEN IN MEMORY OF DECEASED CLASSMATES

Awarded to a student who plans to further his/her education. Awarded on the basis of involvement in school and community, financial need and academic standing. Must be a resident of Amesbury or South Hampton to apply.

AMESBURY HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 2009 SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$500.00)

Awarded to a current Amesbury High School student who has demonstrated an outstanding ability to bring class spirit and unity to those around them. Please include a short essay about a time you have brought school spirit or unity to those around you. (500 words or less) **Must be an Amesbury High School Student to apply.**

AMESBURY HOSPITAL AID SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$1,000.00)

Awarded to a student entering the field of medicine or nursing.

Special letter to the committee required.

AMESBURY HEALTH CARE CHARITABLE TRUST IN MEMORY OF RENA PICARD (2 at \$1,000.00 each)

A scholarship given in memory of Rena Picard will be awarded to a student who plans to further his/her education in the field of medicine.

AMESBURY HEALTH CARE CHARITABLE TRUST IN MEMORY OF JAMES F. WHITTEN, M.D., (2 at \$1,000.00 each)

A scholarship in memory of James F. Whitten, M.D. will be awarded to a student who plans to further his/her education in the field of medicine.

AMESBURY POLICEMEN'S ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$1,000.00)

Awarded to a student to help further his/her education in the field of human services.

AMESBURY SOCCER ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP (2 AT \$500.00 each)

A scholarship given by the Amesbury Soccer Association in memory of James Vatcher. These scholarships will be awarded to student athletes to continue his/her academic and athletic pursuits beyond high school.

BAILEY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$14,000.00)

Provides financial aid for pursuit of the B.S. or B.A. Degree. Student must be in the top 10% of the class. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

EDWIN M. BAILEY AND ELEANOR S. BAILEY SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined)

A scholarship to be awarded annually to a member(s) of the Senior Class. Such award will be made on the basis of the need, worthiness and general scholastic attainments of such member(s) of the Senior Class. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

EDGAR BOTTOME MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (1 AT \$1,500.00)

Awarded to a student who is planning to pursue a liberal arts education. This scholarship will be awarded on the basis of community service, academic achievement, participation school activities and involvement in varsity sports. Must be an Amesbury High School student and an Amesbury resident to apply.

BARNARD SCHOOL P.T.O. SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$500.00)

Awarded to a student to continue schooling beyond high school. The applicant must be a resident of South Hampton and a graduate of the Barnard School. Must be a South Hampton student to apply.

LANCE AND CELINE BLAIKIE MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined)

Given to a student who intends to continue musical study at the college level. The award is based on need, scholarship and contribution to the A.H.S. Music Program. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

GEORGE AND MABEL BLAISDELL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined)

Awarded to a deserving student or students in need of financial assistance to continue his/her college education.

RICKY BLANCHETTE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined)

This scholarship is to be given in memory of Ricky Blanchette, a member of the graduated class of 1986. It is given to a student that has participated in at least one varsity sport. The recipient must possess the ideal that epitomizes the character of Ricky: a work ethic that exemplifies dedication, outstanding sportsmanship, and citizenship that extends beyond the athletic fields into the classroom and community. The award(s) will also be based on need. Preference will be given to a student involved in more than one sport. **Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.**

JEAN AND SPOFF BROWN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$700.00)

To be awarded annually to a student who plans to further his/her education. The applicant must have attended the Amesbury Elementary School on South Hampton Road. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

CECELIA CALDERWOOD WILSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND (1 at \$200.00) Awarded to a student to help further his/her education. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

FIREFIGHTER EDWARD CARROLL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (2 at \$1,000 each)
Awarded to a student, planning on further education, based on financial need, with preference given but not limited to those entering the field of human services.

CLASS OF 1940 SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. To be determined.)

In memory of deceased members. Awarded to a student who plans to continue his/her education beyond high school. Awarded on the basis of character and service to the school.

FIFTY YEAR CLASS ANNIVERSARY SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined) Many awards to students who plan to continue his/her education at the college level.

J. HENRY AND YVONNE G. FOURNIER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$500.00) In memory of J. Henry and Yvonne G. Fournier, Amesbury business owners and charter members of the original Amesbury Business Association. This scholarship was established by his/her children, for seniors attending a full-time Associate Degree Business program. This scholarship will be given to a student residing in Amesbury or South Hampton, and graduating from Amesbury High School. It will be awarded on the basis of achievement, character, academics and financial need.

E. MARION REED GORDON, AMESBURY HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1911 SCHOLARSHIP FUND (Amt. to be determined)

Awarded to a student who wishes to further his/her education at an accredited degree granting college and who shows a financial need.

JON GOULD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$1,000.00)

A scholarship established in the memory of Jon Gould, Amesbury High School Class of 1971. This scholarship is intended for students whose interest lies in the area of fine arts (drama, writing, music). The students need not be high honor students, but one who contributes outstanding service to the school and personifies the ideals of creativity, character, leadership and thoughtfulness toward others. These are the qualities most strongly demonstrated by Jon. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

THE GUILD FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined)

Awarded to a student who is pursuing a college education. Awarded to a student who is in the top third of the class and is planning a career in life sciences, bio-chemistry, engineering or business. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

LOUISE M. HAINES SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined)

Awarded to a student who plans to continue his/her education. Preference given to those planning to enter a mathematics field, though this is not a requirement.

RAYMOND F. JOYCE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined)

The student must be respected by his/her peers as well as members of the faculty. The recipient should demonstrate how they contribute to Amesbury's religious community. The recipient should hold a part-time job and plan to contribute to his/her education. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

SKIP JUTRAS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (2 at \$1,000.00 each)

The Skip Jutras Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior who participates in sports, extracurricular activities, and community service. The student will exhibit the qualities that Skip Jutras valued, which are spirit, determination, and hard work which brings success not only in the classroom, but on the playing field, in the community and wherever your dream takes you. **Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply**.

JOE KARDEK SR., MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$3,000.00)

Awarded to a student in the top third of the class who is pursuing a college education. The student must be respected by his/her peers as well as members of the faculty. The recipient should hold a part-time job and plan to contribute to his/her education.

JOE KARDEK SR., MEMORIAL COMMUNITY SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$3,000.00)

Awarded to a student who has consistently served in the community service program for four years and plans to further his/her education. Student needs to have exhibited dedication, integrity, and leadership skills while serving in the Community. See Mrs. Furlong to include a copy of community service hours.

MERLE D. & JEANNETTE KIMBALL SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined)

A scholarship given in memory of a former Amesbury High School math teacher Merle and his wife Janette.

JACK LABADINI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND (1 at \$2,000.00)

An award given to either a student from Amesbury High School, Ipswich High School. Masconomet Regional High School, Newburyport High School, Pentucket Regional High School, Whittier Regional High School or Pentucket Regional High School for a total value of \$2,000.00. Preference will be given to students with the greatest financial need, highest rank in class and those showing the most interest in the hotel or restaurant industry.

LAWLOR FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined)

Awarded on the basis of character, motivation, scholarship and participation in school and/or community activities. **Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply**. (Preference may be given to a student who contributes musically.)

VERNON LEWIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined)

Awarded to a student who is going to further his/her education who has exhibited qualities of dedication to scholarship and service, integrity and leadership. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

JACK MORRILL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$500.00)

Awarded to a senior student who intends to further his/her education. Preference will be given to applicants who played and will continue to play ice hockey, although all applicants will be evaluated on their merits. The scholarship will be awarded at Amesbury High School where Jack excelled at hockey. The recipient must have demonstrated desire, dedication, character, leadership and citizenship. **Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.**

DANIEL PARKS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$500.00)

Awarded to those entering teaching with a concentration in Special Education, though others will be considered.

VALERIE PINCIARO MEMORIAL FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined) Awarded to a student of outstanding fine arts ability planning to continue education in this field.

THE RON RYAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED BY THE AMESBURY EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION INC. (1 at \$500.00)

Mr. Ryan was an exception teacher. He touched the lives of many children who still remember him fondly today. During his career in Amesbury, he taught 4th and 5th grade at the Amesbury and Cashman Elementary Schools. Choose a teacher from K-5 who touched your life in a special way. Write an essay describing the qualities of this teacher and how he/she impacted your life.

JEFF SANBORN MEMORIAL/CLASS OF 1985 SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$500.00)

Awarded to a student based on these items in this order: 1) need; 2) participation; 3) academics 4) character and 5) leadership. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

MARCI LYN SAYWARD SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined)

Award given in memory of Marci Lyn Sayward, a graduate of the AHS class of 1989 who was studying to become a paralegal. Marci had a zest for life and a love for all people.

OTTO S. WAGNER SCHOLARSHIP TRUST (Amt. to be determined)

A scholarship given in memory of Otto S. Wagner a former ancient history teacher at Amesbury High School. This award is given to a student to further his/her education. **Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.**

THE BIKES WALLACE SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined)

Awarded to one or more graduating seniors who are planning to attend college. The recipient(s) must demonstrate financial need, play at least one varsity sport, and display "determination, hard work" personal characteristics on the playing field and in the classroom. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

THE TERESA BERTOLINI AXTEN SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$500.00)

A scholarship to be awarded annually to a graduating senior who has been accepted in an accredited degree program and has demonstrated a commitment to community service. Must be an Amesbury High School student to apply.

GRACE P. WATKINS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Amt. to be determined)

Awarded to a student who will further his/her education in the field of teaching. The award will be determined on the basis of need.

ROLAND H. WOODWELL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (1 at \$500.00)

This scholarship is given in memory of Amesbury High School English teacher and John Greenleaf Whittier biographer Roland H. Woodwell. It is awarded by the Whittier Home Association to a member of the graduating class who excels in English and is considering entering the field of English education or a related area.
